Dear East Valley Parents:

East Valley School District has several preschool options: ECEAP, I-728, Title I and Special Education. These programs will be available again for the 2009/2010 school year. Transportation will be provided, when possible.

The attached packet should be used for the I-728 program and the Title I program. **There is a separate application for the ECEAP programs.** For more information about ECEAP if you live in the Trentwood Elementary area, please contact Ammie Hawk at 927-3233; if you live in the Trent Elementary area, please contact Stevie Hanson at 893-4122 or Kim Kotlan at 893-4123; if you live in the Otis Orchards Elementary area, please contact Leslie Helms at 893-4125; if you live in the East Farms Elementary area, please contact Shanna Randall 241-5897. Kim Linke is our ECEAP director and can be reached at 241-5021. If you feel your child would qualify for our Special Education preschool program, please call Coleen Bennett at 241-5039.

An academic needs assessment is a part of the Title I preschool entry criteria. If your child is being considered for this program, you will be contacted with additional information. The Title I preschool is available to students who live in the Trent and Trentwood areas. ECEAP, I-728 and Special Education preschool programs are district-wide. If you have preschool questions, please call 241-5011.

Income level and other needs of the family will be considered in the application process for I-728 and ECEAP. If you are interested in having your child attend preschool, please complete the following:

Pick up an application at your elementary school or the East Valley School District office. The district office will remain open during the summer break. Current office hours are 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. OR Download and print the application from our website [www.evsd.org](http://www.evsd.org) under "Our Schools, Early Learning" tab.

To complete the application, you will need to provide your Social Security number and your child's certified birth certificate and immunization record. Registration is open to children four-years old by August 31, 2009. Some three-year olds may be considered if there is space available.

Income verification must be provided by one of the following: check stub from public assistance, copies of pay stub, letter from Department of Child and Family Services, letter from employer, or IRS tax form. If you receive public assistance, you will need to provide your case number. Any other form of income verification must be approved by district personnel.

All I-728 applications and supporting documents must be brought or sent to our district office at: East Valley School District, 12325 East Grace Avenue, Spokane Valley, WA 99216. ECEAP applications should be sent to the appropriate school.
