



Professional Certification Program

Introduction

Washington State University in Spokane is now offering a Professional Certification Program (PCP) with the option of a Master of Education (Ed.M.). This program offers prospective candidates the opportunity to combine the requirements of their PCP with an advanced degree. This program is offered through WSU Spokane as either PCP only or as PCP as a component of a Master's Degree Program.

Program Description

The Professional Certification Program (PCP) offered by Washington State University Spokane will facilitate the successful transition from the Residency Certificate to the Professional Certificate. This is a new requirement for Washington state teachers who have received a residency teaching certificate after August 31, 2000. The program is a cohort model consisting of ten credits that can be completed in one year. This program begins this January (Spring Semester 2004) with the three credit Pre-Assessment Seminar. There will then be two consecutive semesters (Summer and Fall, 2004) consisting of two or three core credits each semester. During these two semesters the Professional Growth Plan (PGP) will be implemented and developed. The PCP will conclude with a two credit Culminating Seminar (Spring 2005) where candidates will refine and present their portfolios. This cohort will be limited to 20 students so please reserve your place by forwarding the application information below.
